

Boris Rebolledo-Jaramillo is an Assistant Professor at the Institute for Science and Innovation in Medicine at Universidad del Desarrollo, Chile. He received his BSc in Bioengineering (2009) and MSc in Bioinformatics (2012) from University of Concepcion, Chile, and PhD (2016) in Bioinformatics and Genomics from Penn State University. Dr. Rebolledo-Jaramillo's work has focused on the development and implementation of bioinformatics methods for the analyses of sequencing data, with an emphasis on mitochondrial genomics. Currently, his work is focused on clinical genomics. Particularly, the clinical consequences of variants affecting the mitochondrial-nuclear genetic coordination, and the implementation of exome sequencing analyses for the diagnostic of rare disorders.
